- Recruit and equip team leaders to grow personally and effectively lead their teams.
- Cultivate a sense of community with leaders so that they are cared for and encouraged in their leadership.
- Compose an annual budget and monitor it throughout the year.
- Collaborative work with the Leadership Team for vision objectives, series and calendar planning
- Preaching as scheduled by the Lead Pastor
