Plan/lead special events (at least quarterly).

Give guidance and encouragement to teens and families in crisis.

Reach out into the community, schools, and homes of students with the love of Christ.

Young Adult/Family Ministries Responsibilities:

The Associate Pastor shall fulfill the following responsibilities himself or ensure that they are being fulfilled.

Connection - Reaching out and inviting into connective relationships personally, in smaller groups, and corporately.

Assimilation - Assisting with the journey from guest to ministry partner.

Discipleship - Training and equipping individuals, couples, and families to live, love, and serve like Jesus.
