The Pacific Northwest Conference of the Free Methodist Church seeks a full-time Lead Pastor for The Rock Church in Olympia, Washington. The church is Christ-centered, Spirit-filled, and grounded in Scripture, with a mission to "Love God. Love Others. Make Disciples." The church has one English-speaking Sunday service with an average of 50 attendees and one Micronesian service with about 20 people. Debt-free, The Rock Church is currently under a dual-appointed leader.

About Olympia:

Olympia is the capital city of Washington State. Located 60 miles south of Seattle, it is known for its cultural hub, state government center, and waterfront views. The city has a quaint downtown with vintage clothing stores, antiquing opportunities, and coffee shops. The community, with a population of around 57,000 and an average age of 41, consists of approximately 78% white

(non-Hispanic) and the remaining 22% consisting of residents from a variety of backgrounds. The city has 40 parks and is committed to education and the safety of its residents. Although a small city, Olympia has the feel of a major urban area, especially due to the tons of fun activities that are present there.

In the PNWC, we believe that every church should have evidence of Spirit-aliveness, multiply disciples who make disciples, develop and mentor leaders, and multiply churches as part of its ethos regardless of size. Applicants should be theologically Wesleyan and aligned with Free Methodist values.
